
## 12 Bar Blues Variation #1

Key of A



Blues is in the form of **I**, **IV**, **V**. That means chords are played on the 1<sup>st</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> notes of the scale. The key of A has 3 sharps, F#, C#, and G#. The musical scale is A–B–C#-D–E–F#-G#-A. Hence, each note in the scale is assigned a number I-VII, and note VIII is the same as I.
