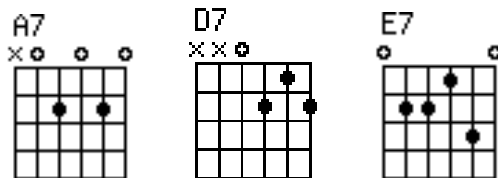


12 Bar Blues Variation #1

Key of A



Blues is in the form of **I, IV, V**. That means chords are played on the 1st, 4th, and 5th notes of the scale. The key of A has 3 sharps, F#, C#, and G#. The musical scale is A-B-C#-D-E-F#-G#-A. Hence, each note in the scale is assigned a number I-VII, and note VIII is the same as I.
