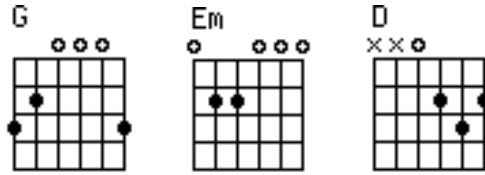


## G, Em, and D Chord Progression
